#### Synopsis :

Saint Paul Police Squad while on tour went to 517 North Snelling on an investigate call at 1043 hours on 02-02-2025. No arrest was made at the time of the incident.

#### Narrative :

Saint Paul Police Squad 135 (Lewis) while on tour was travelling S.B. Snelling at 1045 hours on 02-02-2025. While driving by 517 and 515 N. Snelling I Officer Lewis noticed that the front door to 517 N. Snelling Avenue appeared to be freshly broken out. I drove around the block and returned to park out side the front of the business to investigate.

As I approached the door I noticed that the business appeared to be unoccupied and no longer being used as a convenience store that it had previously been. There were large pieces of glass inside and outside the doorway to the business which still appeared to be secured. I pulled the window shade over the exterior handle to protect myself from the jagged broken glass which still hung in the upper part of the frame. I then searched the interior of the business, which connected 517 and 515 and the downstairs basement to both addresses. I found no one inside the address, but noticed that all the utilities including heat still appeared to be working.

I could not tell what was used to break the window and could collect no evidence of who had done the damage.

I then exited the business. Due to the high amount of unsheltered in the area I suspected that if the business was not secured it would soon be filled with unsheltered persons looking for somewhere warm to stay and use narcotics. I contacted Data and requested a boarding crew respond to board up the broken window to prevent further entry. I remained on scene until the boarding crew arrived to secure the building.
