Dear Council President Noecker and Councilmembers:

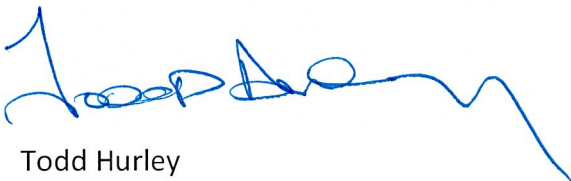
