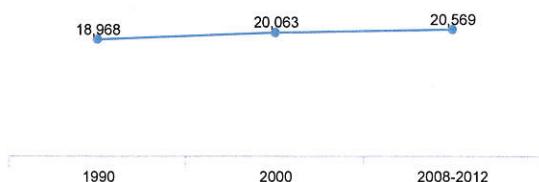

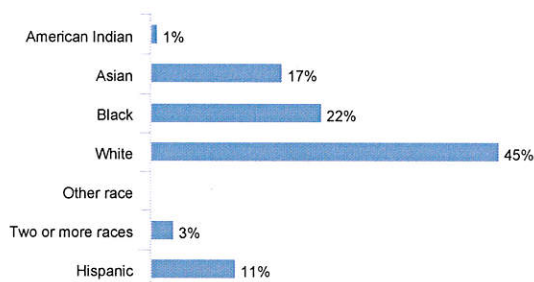

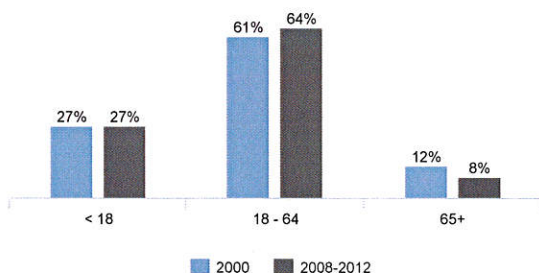
Total population



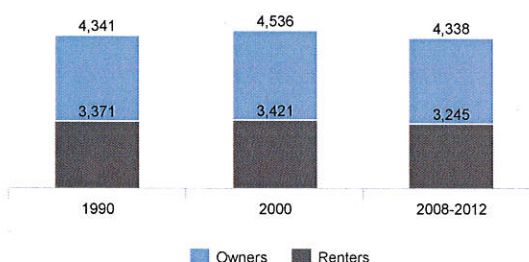
Population by race/ethnicity, 2008-2012



Population by age group



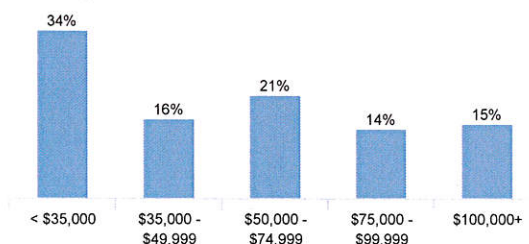
Households by tenure
