**REGARDING: RESOLUTION AMENDING THE HOUSING TRUST FUND PROJECT
BUDGET TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR STAFFING IN THE
DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT,
CITYWIDE**

Requested Board Action

1. Amend the HRA Housing Trust Fund budget as shown in the attached financial analysis.
2. Authorize and direct the Executive Director and staff of the HRA to take all actions needed to implement this resolution.

Background

The Families First Pilot Program budget in the HRA Housing Trust Fund has a remaining balance of \$926,220. There is a need for additional staffing in the Department of Planning and Economic Development to administer the Emergency Rental Assistance Program and other programs. A HRA budget amendment is needed to transfer remaining funds from Families First Pilot Program to PED Operations for PED staffing. The Housing Trust Fund is in the HRA Development Capital Project Fund and a resolution is required for this fund when transferring budget amounts greater than \$100,000. The City's 2026 PED Operations special fund budget will also need to be amended to accept the transfer of funds and use them to hire additional staff.
