Getting Around



Metro Transit

Direct bus and light rail service is available at the State Capitol to take you to and from downtown Saint Paul. Check schedules at metrotransit.org or download the Metro Transit app at metrotransit.org/app.



Green Line

Rice Street Station (Rice Street and University Avenue) and Robert Street Station (Robert Street and 14th Street)



Bus

7 minutes: Route 62B – Capitol to Downtown
Rice Street Station (Rice Street and University Avenue) to Minnesota Street and 4th Street Station, right in the heart of downtown and just 3 blocks from Mears Park and 4 blocks from Rice Park



Evs & Rideshare

Evie, powered by HOURCAR, is our all-electric, free-floating carshare service with over 170 shared vehicles throughout the Twin Cities. Download the app, view the live map, and learn more at eviecarshare.com.



Bikeway

Capital City Bikeway provides separated bikeways and paths and off- and on-road bike lanes from the Capitol grounds to downtown Saint Paul. Explore maps and plan your trip at stpaul.gov/bikes.

Construction

Various city, county, and local road construction projects are taking place throughout downtown Saint Paul this construction season, including:

- Minnesota Street and Robert Street reconstructions
- Replacement of the Kellogg/3rd Street bridge
- Construction of the Capital City Bikeway on Kellogg Boulevard from St. Peter Street to West 7th Street

To get in, out, and around Saint Paul this construction season, plan ahead, and use the road closure map at stpaul.gov/roadclosures. Don't forget to stay up to date with Public Works construction projects by signing up for alerts at stpaul.gov/construction.

Public Safety

- ✓ Fixing and maintaining existing light poles to keep lights on and prevent copper wire theft
