The City Council Public Hearing will be scheduled for Wednesday, May 7, 2025 at 3:30 pm. in room 300 City Hall. You are welcome to attend any of these hearings. If you are contesting Ms. Moermond's recommendation from the April 22 Legislative Hearing, you may appear in person or, should you wish to address testify by phone you must register by noon on the Tuesday May 6 via the link above.
