Your building was inspected on July 17, 2025 for the renewal of your Fire Certificate of Occupancy. Approval for occupancy will be granted upon compliance with the following deficiency list. The items on the list must be corrected prior to the re-inspection date.

A re-inspection will be made on September 18, 2025 at 9:00 am.

Failure to comply may result in a criminal citation or the revocation of the Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The Saint Paul Legislative Code requires that no building shall be occupied without a Fire Certificate of Occupancy. The code also provides for the assessment of additional re-inspection fees.

YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR NOTIFYING TENANTS IF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING LIST OF DEFICIENCIES ARE THEIR RESPONSIBILITY.

DEFICIENCY LIST

1. 2305.2 Equipment maintenance and inspection.
Motor fuel-dispensing facility equipment shall be maintained in proper working order at all times in accordance with Sections 2305.2.1 through 2305.2.5
Continue with your plans to repair the damaged pumps 3 and 4 to bring them back into service.
2. MSFC 2304.3 - Unsupervised dispensing locations must be provided with daily site visits by the owner/operator, regular equipment inspection and maintenance, conspicuously posted instructions for the safe operation of dispensing equipment, a fire alarm transmitting device (a telephone not requiring a coin to operate is acceptable),

posted telephone numbers for the owner/operator and Fire Department and a sign posted in a conspicuous location reading:

'IN CASE OF SPILL OR RELEASE

1. USE EMERGENCY PUMP SHUTOFF!

2. REPORT THE ACCIDENT!

-Provide a fire alarm transmitting device (call box to 911) if permitting unattended self-service dispensing.
