Dear Brian Balsaitis:

This is to confirm that at the Legislative Hearing on October 22, 2024, Legislative Hearing Officer Marcia Moermond continued the matter to Legislative Hearing **Tuesday, November 26, 2024 at 9 am in room 330 City Hall/Courthouse (or via phone between 9 and 11 am)** for further discussion as your Performance Deposit has been posted and Code Compliance Inspection application submitted.

For your reference, the following items need to (eventually) be completed before a grant of time can be given to rehab the property:

- 1. If you are intending to have a third party rehabilitate the property, pending transfer of title, the contract used for this transaction will need to be approved by the Legislative Hearing Officer. Please note that title cannot transfer until the rehabilitation is complete and nuisance abated;
- 2. submit evidence of financing sufficient to complete the rehabilitation. Staff estimates costs to exceed \$75,000. If total for bids are more than 20% less than staff estimate, a high level of detail will be required. Financing could be business or personal accounts, a line of credit, or construction loan. Other types of financing will be reviewed on a case by case basis;
- 3. submit an affidavit indicating the finances will be dedicated to completing the project and not diverted until a code compliance certificate is issued;
- **4. submit work plan, sworn construction statement, or scope of work.** This should include **signed** subcontractor bids which <u>address all items in the Code Compliance Inspection Report</u> and a <u>schedule</u> for completion of the project; and
- 5. the property must be maintained.
