Legislative Code Chapter 293 - Noise Regulations

Application and \$178 fee should be submitted a minimum of sixty (60) days prior to the event date to allow ample time for required public notification period and scheduling of a Council public hearing. Applications submitted within sixty (60) days of the event date may not satisfy the processing timeline requirements.

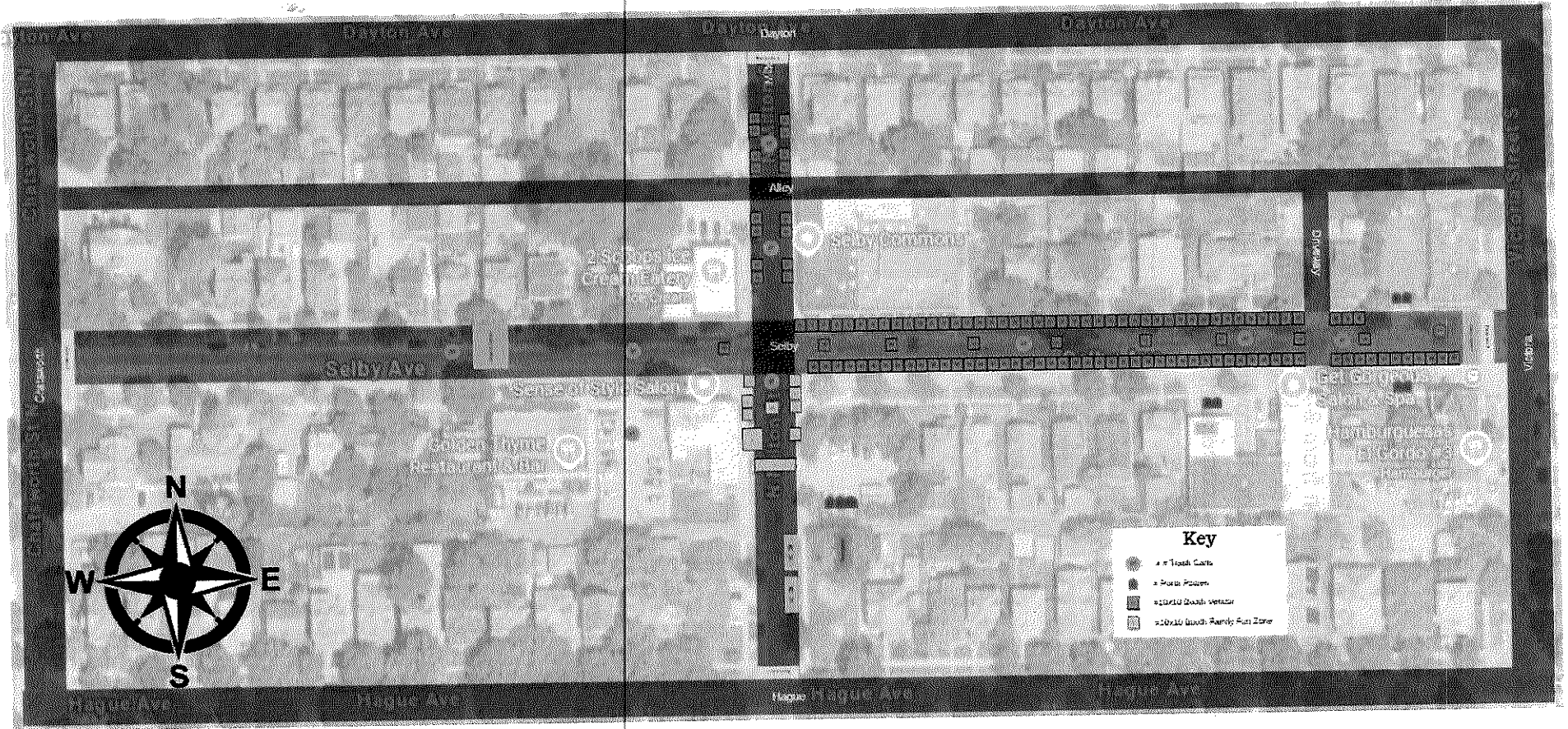

10. Briefly describe the noise source and equipment involved: The primary noise source will be live musical performances that will be amplified via a professional, stage-mounted line array PA system with ground subwoofers, operating during festival hours.
11. Describe the steps that will be taken to minimize the noise levels: We will angle the line array system directly toward the crowd, actively monitor decibel levels, utilizing directional subwoofers to reduce bass bleed and strictly adhering to permitted hours.
12. State reason for seeking variance (example - music, announcements, construction, etc.): Musical performances and community announcements amplified via an outdoor stage PA system for a community music festival.
13. Maximum number of attendees: 10,000

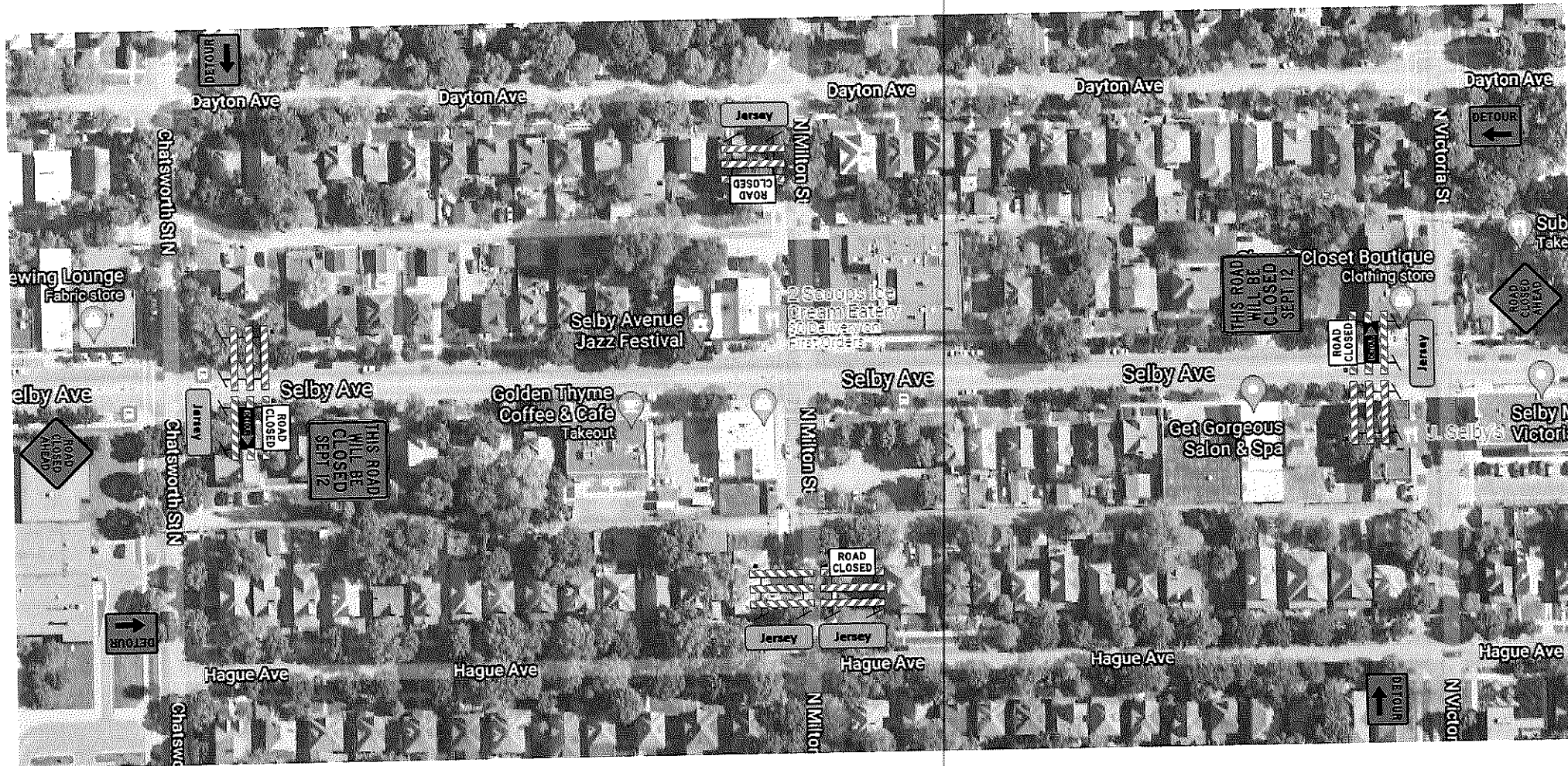

Full Map

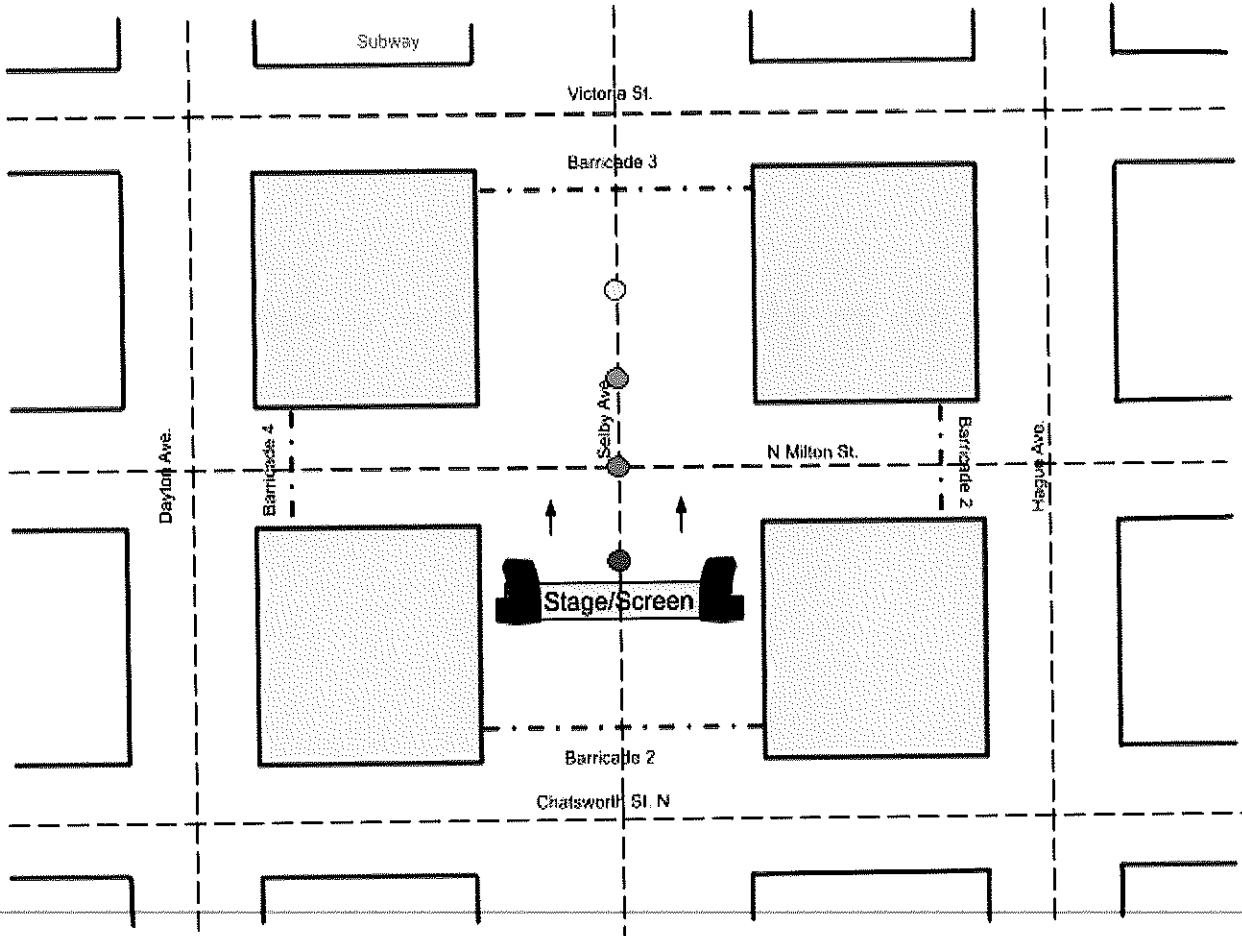

SELBY AT MILTON SAINT PAUL, MN

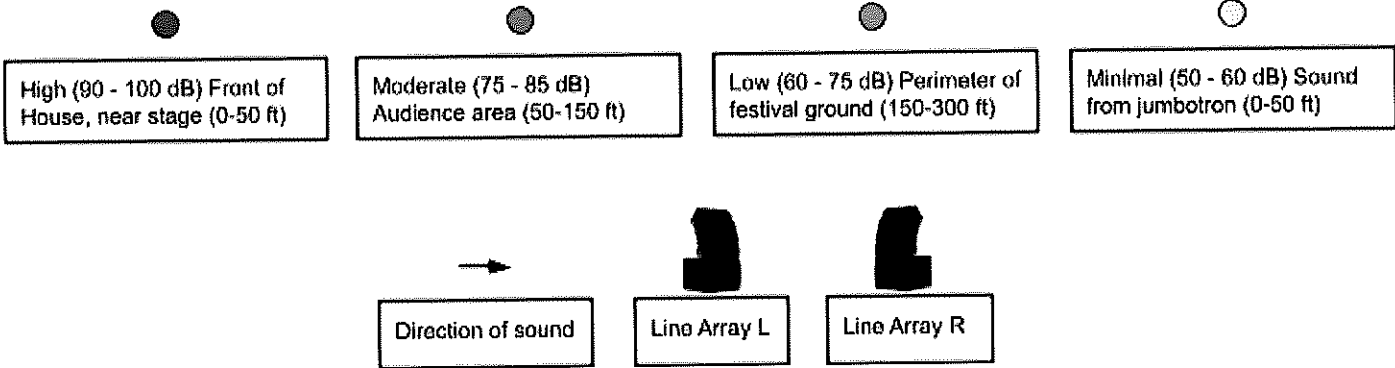
Selby Avenue JazzFest, Saturday, Sept. 12, 2026
