- Install Smoke Detectors/Carbon Monoxide Detectors per MN Conservation Code and the MN Dept. of Labor and Industry: Install per code where feasible. MNRC Ch 1309 Sect 313.2.1
- This property was inspected as a Single Family Dwelling.
- \*\*\*Remove rear porch and replace with code compliant steps and/or new porch.
- \*\*\*Basement walls: Remove all loose, delaminated, skim coating and patch in a manner approved by inspector.
- \*\*\*Install new overhead garage door
- \*\*\*Garage is tilted. Rack back to plumb and brace in an approved manner.

- A building permit is required to correct the above deficiencies. All added receptacles must be grounded, tamper-resistant and be on an Arc-Fault Circuit Interrupter-protected circuit.
- Any open walls or walls that are opened as part of this project must be wired to the standards of the current NEC.
- All electrical work must be done by a Minnesota-licensed electrical contractor under an electrical permit. All the above corrections to waste, vent, water, and gas piping shall be per the Minnesota Plumbing Code Chapter 4715 & Chapter 326, the Minnesota Mechanical Code, the Minnesota Fuel Gas Code, and the Saint Paul Regional Water Code. All plumbing must be done by a plumbing contractor licensed in the State of Minnesota and the City of St. Paul under an approved permit.
